Kitchen Towel Boa

You will need one kitchen towel (or tea towel) and 10" strip (WOF) of a coordinating fabric.

Trim off the salvage edges. Fold up the two "salvage" edges ½ inch (wrong sides together) and press.

Fold the fabric in half lengthwise (right sides together) and press. Sew down the long edge, backstitching at the beginning and end.

Turn the tube right side out.

Fold the towel in half (short sides together) and cut along the fold. The cut edge will be sown into the fabric so don't worry about it being an unfinished edge.

Gather or fold the towel until it is about the same size as the tube opening. Insert a towel half into one opening of the tube, making sure it goes in about an inch. Pin in place and sew a top stitch near the pressed edge of the tube. Backstitch at the beginning and end. Repeat with the other half of the towel and the other opening of the tube. MAKE SURE THAT THE FRONT OF THE TOWELS ARE FACING THE SAME WAY SO THEY BOTH SHOW AS IT IS BEING WARN.

You can do a double or triple row of top stitching if you want.
